 - The Commission prepares and adopts, and may amend from time to time, the Master Plan for the physical development of the City. The Commission holds the initial hearings relative to proposed subdivision plats, proposed rezoning, and proposed changes in the zoning ordinance, and makes recommendations thereon to the Council.
- [Board of Adjustment & Appeals \(1 Position\)](#)
 - The Board of Adjustment and Appeals has the power to make exceptions to the terms of the zoning regulations in harmony with their general purpose and intent to authorize variances from the strict application of the zoning regulations in such situations, subject to such limitations as may be set by ordinance.





ORGANICS ROLL OFF

Accepted : Grass clippings, leaves, branches, logs, stumps, paper leaf bags (NO PLASTIC)
NOT Accepted : Plastics, Food

LANDSCAPE & YARD MATERIALS

Accepted : Limbs, yard clippings, leaves, wood mulch
NOT Accepted : Concrete, dirt, large stumps, fertilizers, chemicals, rocks

METAL MATERIALS

Accepted : Metal flashing, metal furniture, household metals
NOT Accepted : Refrigerators, freezers, A/C units, any appliances with freon, lawn mowers

AUTOMOTIVE

Accepted : Bumpers, auto body panels, seats, upholstery
NOT Accepted : Tires, car/truck batteries, vehicle fluids, motor oil plastic bottles, windshield glass

Electronic Recycling & Shredding Services Not Available

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

Accepted : Wood, drywall, windows, doors, decking, carpet, flooring
NOT Accepted : Concrete, bricks, paints/stains, chemicals

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Accepted : Household trash, furniture, linens, clothes.
NOT Accepted : Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste, needles, syringes, hot tubs, batteries.

NOT ACCEPTED

Tires, car/truck batteries, vehicle fluids, motor oil plastic bottles, windshield glass, refrigerators, freezers, A/C units, any appliances with freon, lawn mowers, Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste, needles, syringes, hot tubs, batteries, bricks, paints/stains, chemicals, dirt, large stumps, fertilizers, chemicals, rocks

Save your leaves to take care of our earth!


The leaves are changing color and starting to fall to the ground. Historically, many of Edgewater's leaves have been bagged up and sent to the landfill. While the landfill may be a cheap choice, it is costly to the environment and even the air we breathe. When you place organic materials such as leaves, yard waste, and food scraps into the landfill it breaks down to release higher levels of methane.
